2023-2024 BITTERSWEET STUDENT/ADULT SKI/SNOWBOARD CLUB RULES AND RATES

STUDENT SKI/SNOWBOARD CLUB

- ✓ Card can be used for one **BEGINNER LIFT TICKET** and rental equipment discounts.
- ✓ Members may not be over 18 years of age unless still in high school and at least 7 years of age. No lessons available under this program for children under 7 yrs.
- ✓ One lesson is included. Additional group lessons will be available to ski club students for a discounted rate of \$20 per student. **All students must be evaluated** by a Ski School Instructor and given a 2nd evaluation lift ticket prior to boarding chair lifts and entering more advanced areas. This 2nd evaluation lift ticket is to be worn on student's coat all season and be in addition to the daily lift ticket. Replacement evaluation lift tickets are available in the Bittersweet office or at Ski School upon presentation of a punched ski club card.

ADULT SKI/SNOWBOARD CLUB

- ✓ Card can be used for one All Area ticket and rental equipment discounts.
- ✓ Lessons are not included for adult ski club members.
- ✓ Available to anyone age 18 or older. (Not still in high school).

SKI CLUB MEMBER LIMITATIONS:

Your card may not be used by anyone but the card holder's name listed on the card. Club Sponsors will report club members lost or stolen cards to Bittersweet's office. Cards may be replaced via the club sponsor for \$32.

WEEKDAYS (non-Holiday): Cards are valid on your designated ski club day from 10am-10pm. WEEKENDS & HOLIDAYS: Cards are valid: after 3pm on Sundays, and holidays. Holidays include: Christmas Break (December 18, 2023 through January 01, 2024), Martin Luther King, Jr. Weekend (January 12-15, 2024) and Presidents Day Weekend (February 16-19, 2024).

NOTE: Management may revoke passes at any time, without refund, for conduct considered inappropriate.

BITTERSWEET STUDENT SKI CLUB PROGRAM

The Bittersweet Ski Club program is offered to groups of **students ages 7-18 (over 18, if still in High School).**

Student Ski Club cards offer the student discounted **Beginner Area** lift tickets and equipment rentals **after 3PM on Sundays** and 10AM-10PM on their individual Ski Club designated day.

One group lesson is included with each card to encourage students to improve their skiing/snowboarding techniques. Beginner, Intermediate and Advanced lessons will be offered on selected dates during the season on their designated ski club night at 4pm, 5pm & 6pm. Additional group lessons will be available to ski club students at a discounted rate of \$20 per lesson. All students must be evaluated prior to entering more advanced areas. Evaluations are available at 4 pm, 5pm & 6pm on their designated ski club night. Lessons and evaluations will not be available on Sundays. This policy is for the safety and enjoyment of all participants. The student's ability will determine the area they will be allowed to use. Lessons may be limited, so please contact Bittersweet Ski School for availability prior to arrival.

Student cards cost \$32. If lost or stolen, replacement cards are available for \$32 from the Ski Club sponsor. Lift tickets for club members is \$32. Ski rental is \$32, snowboard rental is \$32 and helmet rental is \$15. Students will not receive the discounted rate if they do not present their card upon purchase.

RENTAL PROCEDURES

The student will receive a rental form upon purchase. The form will be completed by the student and given to the Rental Department. The Student Card will serve as identification. **All students who rent will need to know their height, weight, shoe size and skill level.**

SPONSOR RESPONSIBILITIES

Each student will complete the Student Disclaimer sheet and turn it in to the sponsor. ALL Student Information forms must be signed by a parent, including those for students not renting equipment. The Student Information forms and payment to join the ski club are collected by the sponsor and turned in to the office at Bittersweet. Student Ski Club cards may be picked up at this time. All cards must be filled out completely by the student or sponsor. The cards will not be accepted at the ticket window unless they are filled out with their name and club name. Additional members may be added anytime during the season through the sponsor. Cards will not be sold to individuals through the office.

Sponsors will pre-order lift tickets and rental to be picked up and sold to the students prior to or on the day of your designated Ski Club night. You are responsible for returning any unsold rental forms and lift tickets by 7:30pm and make final payment or billing arrangements at that time. This enables the students to spend less time in line and more time on the snow.

Season Passes: Ski Club Sponsors whose Ski Club meets eligibility requirements (commit to 5 visits during the season with alternate make-up days), will receive a complimentary Bittersweet only family season pass (**sponsor**, **spouse and any children under 21 living in the same household).** Check with the office for additional chaperone passes and rentals on your Ski Club night. Depending on the size of the Ski Club, additional family passes may be available for up to two additional organizers/administrators (ie- Assistant to the Sponsor and/or record keeping person at the school, if applicable).

BITTERSWEET ADULT SKI CLUB PROGRAM 2023-2024

The Bittersweet Ski Club program is offered to adults ages 18 and older (not in High School). Adult Ski Club cards are \$32.00. Ski Club member rates are \$35.00 for an all-area lift ticket and \$35.00 for equipment rentals. Helmet rental is \$15 at all times.

These rates are NOT a half off discount but are a significant discount of regular rates. Adult Ski Club rates are available **after 3PM on Sundays** and 10AM-10PM on your **Ski Club's designated weekday**.

- One person from each Ski Club must be designated as the Sponsor for their club. The Sponsor will be responsible for providing club members with all information regarding club membership (including, but not limited to, lift ticket and rental rates, times and dates cards are valid).
- Sponsors must also provide Bittersweet with the completed Adult Ski Club information sheet along with the payment for the Adult Ski Club cards. The Sponsor will then receive the Adult Ski Club cards. Cards shall not be issued until payment is received.
- Replacement cards and additional members may be added at any time
 through the Sponsor. The Ski Club cards must be <u>filled out completely</u>
 with the club members signature prior to use. The Sponsor is also
 responsible for informing all members of the correct rates for lift tickets
 and rentals, and times their card is valid.




Skiers:

Wedge turning and stopping

Snowboarders:

Direction changes; stopping




Skiers:

Controlled Wedge Christie turns (starting to match skis throughout turn). Controlled stop.

Snowboarders:

Controlled, linked "S" turns on toe and heel edge. Able to stop on both sides.



Skiers:

Controlled dynamic parallel turns and hockey stop.

Snowboarders:

Controlled dynamic turns on both toe and heel side; controlled stops on both edges



Please note:

The Terrain Park requires Freestyle skills. We do not teach and cannot evaluate for these skills. You assume the responsibility.

Check snow conditions each time you come out. Start slow and be safe.

Bittersweet Student Ski/Snowboard Club Program

The Bittersweet Student Ski/Snowboard Club Program is designed to encourage members to improve their skiing or snowboarding skills. Each paid member will receive a membership card which entitles the student to receive one complimentary group lesson as well as a discount on lift tickets and rentals for skiing and snowboarding. All students, especially beginners, are encouraged to take lessons. All students must be evaluated by Bittersweet Ski School staff before being allowed on any slope rated more difficult than the beginner area. The evaluation consists of the students demonstrating their best skiing/riding skills on the beginner hill. Lessons and evaluations occur 4:00, 5:00, and 6:00pm on your ski club day.

All students must purchase a daily student lift ticket to use any of the hills, and must have an additional evaluation ticket if they are using any chairlifts.

Evaluation Ticket Levels and Criteria	Terrain and Lifts Available	
No evaluation ticket	Student remains in the beginner area serviced	
Working on stopping and turning	by tow ropes and Magic Carpets.	
Green evaluation ticket	Can use Sweet Pea, Creeping Myrtle, and	
Skiers - wedge turning and stopping	Chickory chairlifts, and ski/ride any green slopes.	
Snowboarders - direction changes with a stop		
Blue evaluation ticket	Can use Sweet Pea, Creeping Myrtle, Chickory,	
Skiers - Wedge Christie turn and controlled stop	and Snow Flyer chairlifts. Can ski/ride any green and blue slopes.	
Snowboarders – controlled "S" turns; controlled stop.		
Orange evaluation ticket	Students may ski/ride all lifts and slopes.	
Skiers – controlled dynamic parallel turns and hockey stop.		
Snowboarders - dynamic turns and stops on both edges.		

A word of **caution:** The evaluations are a guideline for the student, sponsor, parent, and area personnel to determine and encourage the student to learn a lifelong sport safely for themselves and others. **Snow conditions change and students must understand the importance of skiing and snowboarding under control at all times.**

The club sponsor is an integral part of making the program work. Helping the students understand how the evaluation process works is as important as organizing the student's paperwork and cards, setting up a weekly club day, helping students with lift tickets, rentals, etc., and safety on the hill. The sponsor's and the program's goals are the same - to make the student's visit a safe and fun learning experience.
