 - One paragraph that defends your thesis. This paragraph should include
 - One current event that support your thesis
 - One excerpt from the Declaration to support your thesis
 - A short conclusion where you summarize your thesis and the evidence used to support it

Four Main Principles of the Declaration of Independence

- 1. All people are created equal
- 2. All people have basic rights that cannot be taken away
- 3. The government gets its power to make decisions and protect rights from the people.
- 4. When the government does not protect the rights of the people, the people have the right to alter or abolish the government.
